



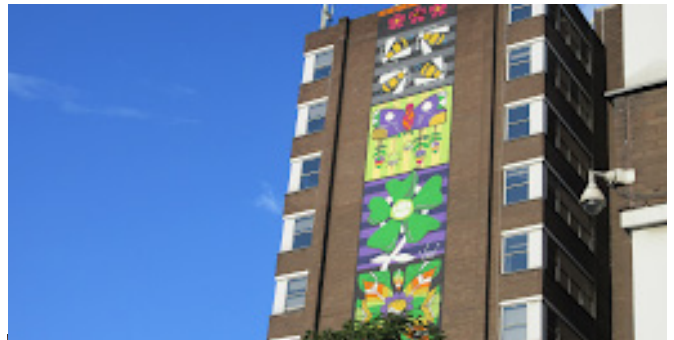
GORGEOUS GORSE HILL
